

Cabin Camp Packing List

- 1 Night Sleepout at Lodge or Cabin.
- No bedding needed – regular bed and mattress provided by camp.
- Webelos Scouts from associated Cub Pack are guests.
- Meals provided by Camp Staff.
- Scouts are allowed to bring electronic games/devices.
- Scouts perform community work (cleanup) around camp.
- Pack into duffel bag or 2900 cubic inch backpack.
- Check weather forecast for weekend.
- Pack appropriate Clothing.

Personal Gear:

(2) Class B T-shirts (1 worn in travel, 1 in the pack) (Change into at bedtime)
Class B Pants
Underwear (1 pair worn in travel, 1 pair in the pack) (Change into at bedtime)
Sweat Pants (Pajamas)
Sweat Shirt or Polar Fleece Jacket
Stocking Cap (Depending on the weather)
Coat (Depending on Weather)
Wool Hiking Socks (1 pair worn in travel, 1 pair in the pack) (Change into at bedtime)
Sock Liners (1 pair worn in travel, 1 pair in the pack) (Change into at bedtime)
Hiking Boots
Pillow (Camp provides bedding including regular bed with mattress)
Rain Suit (Pants and Jacket)
Scout Handbook
2 Nalgene Bottles (1 – Water ONLY, 1 – Smellable Juice)
Personal First Aid Kit
Personal Grooming Kit (Includes mirror, toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, soap, washcloth)
Hand Sanitizer (Travel Size)
Insulated Mug with Lid
Flashlight
Pocket Knife
Multi-Purpose Tool
Pencil/Pen
Note Pad
Deck of Playing Cards/Dice
Leather Work Gloves (For Cleanup of Camp)
Handkerchief/Tissues
Sewing Kit (Buttons, thread, needle and thimble)
